

Flying Solutions for Patients with Eustachian Tube Dysfunction

The following combination of medication used with the appropriate earplugs will help you during your upcoming flight to reduce pain and pressure in the ears. All of the following products could be purchased at your local pharmacy and are available without a prescription. Generic or store brand products are acceptable.



• Afrin. Active ingredient: Oxymetazoline. Use 2 sprays in each nostril 30 minutes before take-off and landing.



• Sudafed. Active ingredient:
Pseudoephedrine. Take as directed 30
minutes before take-off. Depending on how
long your flight is, you may need a second
dose to control symptoms for the duration
of the flight.



• <u>Earplanes</u> (ear plugs). Insert in both ears upon take-off and leave in for the duration of the flight.
