



New Jersey Out of Network Consumer Protection, Transparency, Cost Containment and Accountability Act

Governor Phil Murphy has recently passed new legislation in New Jersey to protect patients from receiving “surprise bills”. This new law enacts certain procedures that physicians, hospitals and other facilities must follow in order to fully inform their patient of their network participation and standard rates.

If your insurance is one that this facility participates with, the following does not pertain to you. However, we believe it is important to inform all patients of this new law.

- **We are committed to providing information to our patients to protect them from receiving surprise medical bills.**
- **We are committed to price transparency.**
- **We have worked to meet the requirements of this new state law.**
- **We strongly urge all patients to contact their insurance carrier with any questions regarding practice’s participation.**
- **We have listed on our website all insurance plans that this facility participates with.**
- **This law does not apply to carriers outside of NJ.**
- **This law may not apply to all self-funded plans and patients should contact their carrier if unsure this law applies to them.**
